Did you know?

Having a doula present before and during birth can decrease length of labor, use of epidurals, Pitocin, cesarean section and forceps but even more importantly, studies have shown women who used doulas had a more positive feeling about their birth, their newborn and even about their partners.

What is a doula?



A doula can be a sherpa! "Asking your husband or partner to be your sole guide through labor is like asking him to lead you all the way to the summit of Mt. Everest. Yes, he may be smart and trustworthy, and you love him, but in the Himalayas you'd both be a lot better off with a Sherpa!" ref. Birthing from Within by England and Horowitz
